Specific Regulations

1 Organisation

The Open de Suède/Swedish Open is organised by Vårgårda Cykelklubb, Box 55, S-447 22 Vårgårda under regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI) on Sunday August 1 2010.

2 Type of event

The event is open to athletes of the Women Elite categories. The event is entered on the UCI World Women Calendar.

The event is registered as UCI Road Women World Cup event. Points are awarded for the UCI Road Women World Cup ranking as follows:

3 Participation

As per article 2.14.004 of the UCI regulations, the event is open for UCI Women Team and National Team.

As per article 2.14.005 of the UCI regulations, teams must be formed of minimum 4 and maximum 6 riders.

4 Race Headquarters

Race headquarters is located at the Start- and Finish Area in Vårgårda, and will be open as follows;

5 Radio-Tour

Race information will be given over Radio Tour on frequency 146,4125 MHz.

6 Neutral Technical Support

The neutral support is handled by the organiser with 3 cars.

7 Finishing time limits

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 5% shall not be placed. The time limit may, in exceptional circumstances, be increased by the Commissaires Panel in agreement with the organizer.

8 Classification

The following classifications will be issued:

- Individual classification by time.
- Classification by team, adding the individual classification points from the 4 best placed riders from each team.

10 Antidoping

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

The antidoping tests will take place at Vårgårda Health Centre, Centrumgatan 2, approximately 400 meters from Start- and Finish area.

11 Awards ceremony

In accordance with article 2.14.008 of the UCI rules, the following riders must attend the official awards ceremony:

- The first 3 teams of the event.
- The individual leader of the UCI Road Women World Cup after the event.

The riders have to be present at the podium in a time limit of maximum 5 minutes after arrival of the last finishing team.

After the award ceremony are the winning team and the leader of the UCI Road Women World Cup after the event required to attend the press conference in the company of the organizer.

12 Penalties

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable

31 Course

The course is described in the enclosed road maps, profiles and calculated passing times.
12 laps of each 11,0 km = 132 km.

32 Team Presentation

All teams will be presented to the spectators, in reverse order according to starting list, at the podium on Murartorget, Vårgårda (in the start-area). The presentation starts at 11.30 (1h 30 min before start).

33 Start

Start at 13.00.

34 Equipment

All riders have to wear electronic device to be automatically registered for finish. Information will be given on the team managers meeting and at the registration.

35 Radio Communication

All vehicles following the race must be equipped with working radiocommunication. Radios are distributed at the Service area one (1) hour before start time.

After the race, radios must be returned to Race Communication Centre, otherwise the team will be charged a cost of SEK 5000/ Euro 545.

Radio Tour will operate on frequency 146,4125 MHz.

The race will also be broadcasted over the local radio network, 98,6 MHz (in Swedish only).

36 Feeding

Feeding is allowed within the feeding zones and from car according to UCI-regulations. Information will be given at the team managers meeting.

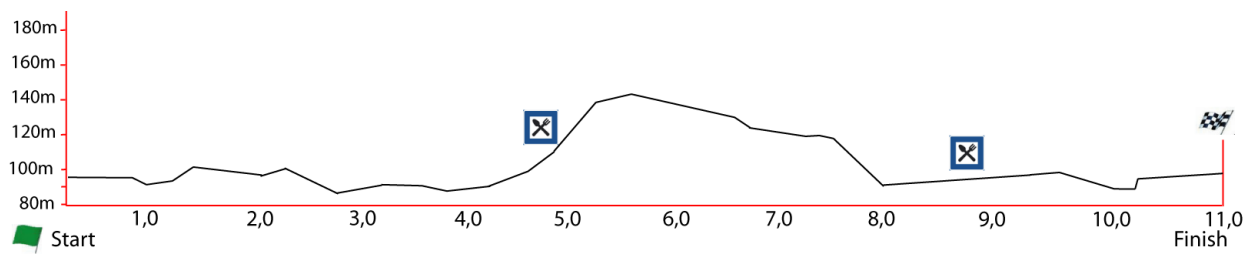

Profile



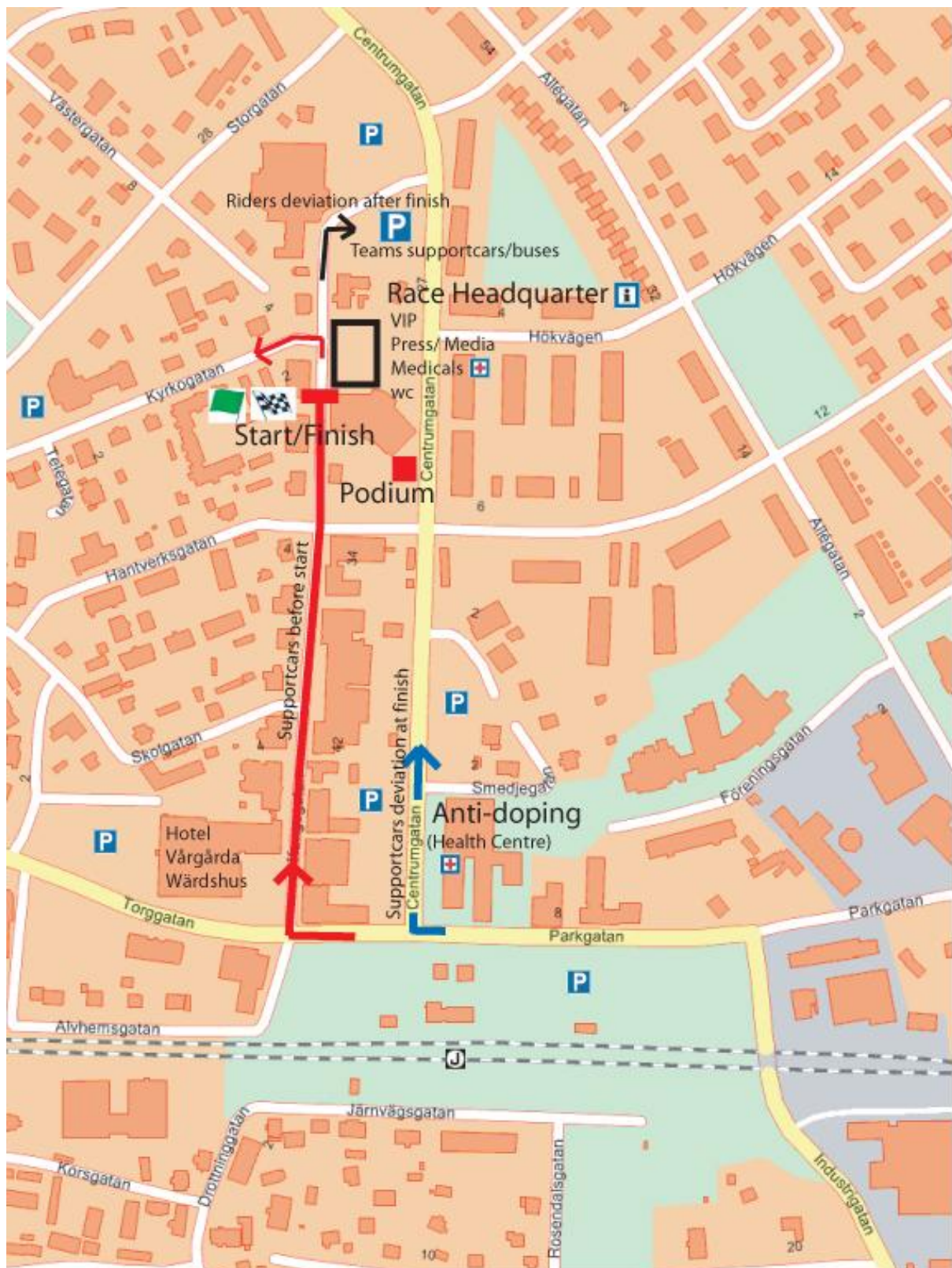
Course, last 3 km
